KONARK

The magnificient Sun Temple at Konark is the culmination of Odishan temple architecture and one of the most stunning monuments of religious architecture in the world. Poet Rabindranath Tagore said, "here the language of stone surpasses the language of man". And it is true that the experience of Konark is impossible to translate into words.





CHILIKA

Queen of natural beauty - Chilika, is the largest brackish water lake in Asia covering an area of over 1,100 sq. km and is a great attraction to the tourists for fishing, bird watching and boating. Here one can see indigenous and migratory birds of many varities and species.

PURI

One of the four celebrated religious dhams of India-Puri is the abode of Lord Jagannath and needs no introduction. According to tradition, Puri was once a hill with thick wods, inhabited by the Sabaras (Pre-Aryan and Pre-Dravidian tribes of the Austric linguistic family).





CUTTACK

Cuttack, the former capital and one of the oldest cities of Odisha, is the administrative headquarters of the district. The town is situated at the apex of the delta formed by the rivers Mahanadi in the North and Kathajodi in the South.

NANDANKANAN

Amidst the natural beauty of the natural forests, adjacent to Chandaka-Dampara Wildlife Sanctuary, Nandankanan lies in the vicinity of Kanjia lake. The Nandankanan zoological park is enriched with 101 enclosures with 202 sub-enclosures. It has the significance of having both the cages and open moat enclosures.





DHAULI

Surrounded by paddy fields, the Dhauli hill brings back memories of the historic 'Kalinga war' which was fought around here. It is here that Ashoka the terrible, was transformed into Ashoka the compassionate and championed the cause of Buddhism.

SATPADA is located at the northeast cape of Chilika Lake and Bay of Bengal. The famous Chilika dolphins can be seen in their natural best here. There are also ample opportunities for canoeing, kayaking and boating. A small island called "Rajahamsa" is situated near this place at the mouth of the lagoon, named after a bird Rajahamsa. This island is 18 kilometer from Satapada.
